


Howard Harden, Evangelist

Returning for the seventh year, Jeff is excited about the possibilities that lie ahead in ministry with our youth. Jeff started his spiritual leadership




journey as a junior high Sunday School teacher and then became the youth pastor at the Zion UMC in York. This year Jeff will be joined by
