Wayne Ayer, Evangelist

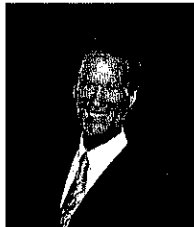

## Our Music Team

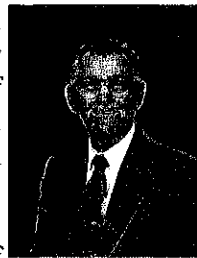
July 26—August 9

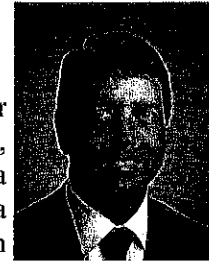


## Teaching our Children

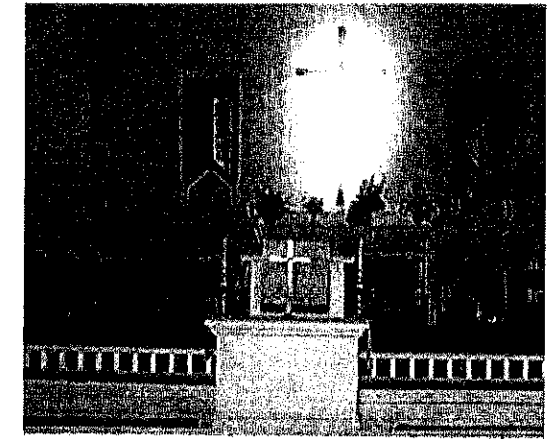
