



Bishop Jeremiah Park will be the keynote preacher for the 2018 Campmeeting. He will be preaching at the Sunday morning worship service on July 22, at 10:30 a.m. Bishop Park is the presiding bishop of The Susquehanna Conference.

He was born on July 4, 1952, in Jae Chun, Korea. He graduated from Seoul Methodist Theological School, as an honor student, with a Bachelor of Divinity degree in 1973 and cum laude from the Theological School of Drew University with the M.Div. degree in 1979 and received his D. Min. degree from Drew in 1990.

Bishop Park began his leadership of the Susquehanna Conference, Harrisburg Area, September 1, 2012.



Dr. Jon Tal Murphree, B.A., M.Div., Litt.D. will be our evangelist Sunday, July 22 through Thursday, July 26. Professor Emeritus at Toccoa Falls College in Georgia.

Former academic dean and vice president of Vennard College in Iowa.

Former administrative director of SIFAT, a missionary training organization.

Author of 24 books, including Christian fiction, inspiration, biography, and academic books in apologetics, theology, psychology, and evangelism.

Has been conference speaker and church/camp evangelist in more than 600 multiple-day series in a majority of the states and in other countries.

His pulpit ministry has included more than 65 denominations and many unaffiliated groups.

Ordained as clergyman in the United Methodist Church.

Listed as educator, administrator, author, public speaker and evangelist in each edition of *Who's Who* for the last 25 years.




Rev. John Shypulefski will be our Evangelist for Saturday evening, August 4.

Rev. David Duty will be our Worship Leader/Choir Director for the two weeks of campmeeting.




Miss Jen has been a cottageholder for 16 years, and is proud to say that she is a sixth generation campground kid!
