grands and great grands. She loves teaching the word and looks forward to returning this year to lead Bible Study for the second week of campmeeting.

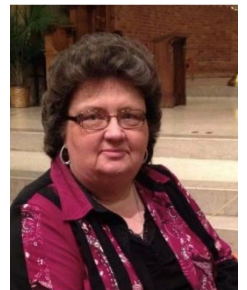
Music Team
